

Dave Young Memorial Science Scholarship - Guidelines For Students And Teachers

The Dave Young Memorial Science Scholarships shall be awarded at the academic presentation evening for each school.

Purpose

The Dave Young Memorial Science Scholarship was established in the memory of Dave Young who died during the Auckland Anniversary floods of January 2023. Dave was a passionate and enthusiastic science teacher at Pukekohe High School, these scholarships are designed to help our taiohi (young people) have a positive effect on their future by supporting post high school studies in a science related area. The scholarships are to encourage students who have not qualified for other scholarships and for whom post high school study is a challenge for financial reasons.

Value and Duration

- Two Dave Young Memorial Science Scholarships will be awarded annually, one to a Pukekohe High School student and one to an Onewhero Area School student.
- Each scholarship recipient will be provided with an initial award of \$1,000.
- On successful completion of their second semester of study, a second award of \$500 will be paid to each scholarship recipient.
- The Dave Young Memorial Science Scholarship is paid for the first year of study only.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Recipients of the *Dave Young Memorial Science* Scholarship must be students at Pukekohe High School, or Onewhero Area School.
- 2. Recipients must be intending to enrol in a tertiary education course in a science related area of study.

Selection

- The Dave Young Memorial Science Scholarship Trust shall ask the Science Faculty at each school to assess their students and make the scholarship award.
- The teachers should consider any or all of the following factors when selecting the Dave Young Memorial Science Scholarship for their school:
 - A pupil who has struggled academically, but tries all the time and wishes to continue further study at some level.



- A pupil who has worked through adversity in order to achieve their grades at school and wishes to continue further study at some level.
- A pupil who is academically able, but who may struggle financially and for whom the grant would help fund their further education.
- o A pupil from a disadvantaged home who wants to continue further study.

Conditions of award

- The scholarship is for students enrolled in tertiary study in a science related field, this can include apprenticeships, vocational training and diplomas.
- Students will be required to contact the Trust to confirm their ongoing study in the 2nd semester of their first year to receive the second payment of their scholarship.
- The *Dave Young Memorial Science Scholarship* must be taken up for the year for which it was offered and may not be deferred to a later year.
